The MCLE presentation will be provided by law students from the Civil Rights Clinic at UC Davis School of Law. The presentation will begin at 12:30 and will qualify for 0.5 hours of MCLE credits.

The UC Davis School of Law Civil Rights Clinic allows students to advocate for the civil rights of prisoners and other indigents. Students have addressed far-reaching constitutional issues in the Ninth Circuit and U.S. Supreme Court. Cases have included claims of denial of medical or dental care, correctional officer misconduct, denial of freedom of religion, violation of due process, excessive force, and false imprisonment. Clinic students are also encouraged to investigate matters involving gender, employment, education, housing, and police practices that may give rise to civil rights claims on behalf of indigent clients.

Additional Meeting Agenda Items:

- 1. The board of the Yuba Sutter Bar Association is still working on completing a list of past YSBA presidents. If anyone knows of any past YSBA presidents, especially those who served during the 1980s, please let us know.

Every president since then has issued a Law Day proclamation on May 1 to celebrate the nation's commitment to the Rule of Law.

In previous years, the YSBA has organized an event on May 1, where attorneys volunteer to give presentations at local schools. If anyone is willing to be part of this event, please let us know.
