 The MCLE presentation was provided by Cory Hamma, the Director of Digital Forensics and Califorensics, Sacramento. The topic was, "Ethical Duties and Electronically Stored Information," and it qualified for one hour of MCLE ethics credits.

- a. Electronic Discovery: The process of locating, securing, and searching Electronically Stored Information (ESI) to use as evidence in a legal proceeding.
- b. Computer Forensics: Going further than E-Discovery: The use of specialized techniques for recovery, authentication and analysis of Electronically Stored Information (ESI).
- c. Metadata: A set of data that describes and gives information about other data.
