The MCLE presentation will be provided by three candidates in the local elections: Brandon Barnes for Sutter County Sheriff and Wendell Anderson for Yuba County Sheriff. The presentation will begin at 12:20 and will qualify for 0.5 hours of MCLE credits.

- Brandon Barnes is a 22-year veteran of the Yuba County Sheriff's Department. Currently, he holds the rank of Captain and Jail Commander. Prior to this, he served as SWAT Commander and Lieutenant assigned to investigations. He is a graduate of the FBI National Academy and the California P.O.S.T. Command College Leadership program. He has served as a Police Academy Instructor since 2015.
- Wendell Anderson is a lifelong Yuba County resident and a 21-year veteran of the Yuba County Sheriff's Department. He currently holds the rank of Lieutenant, is Chief of the Detective Bureau, managing 6 detectives and administrative staff, and he serves as Yuba County's SWAT Commander. He is the current President of Yuba County's Management/Supervisor Association and has held that position for the past several years. He also serves as an instructor at the Yuba College Police Academy. He earned an AS in criminal justice at Yuba College and he is a graduate of the Sherman Block Leadership Institute, management and leadership development courses and other advance training.

Yuba Sutter Bar Association Meeting Minutes April 17, 2018 The Refuge Restaurant

1. Courtney Gengler, President, began the meeting with welcoming remarks and announcements.
 - a. We have received over 35 applications (now over 50 applications) from seniors at the ten local high schools for the YSBA scholarship. The winners will be announced at the school award ceremonies in May.
 - b. YSBA member dues for 2018 are \$50.00. Please pay your dues to help support the YSBA.
 - c. As of March 1, 2018, Sutter County Superior Court now offers optional e-filing in criminal cases.
 - d. The May YSBA meeting will be on May 15. We will be hearing from Deborah Christensen Short about MediCal planning.
2. The speakers were three candidates in the upcoming local elections: Amanda Hopper for Sutter County District Attorney and Jeff Pierce for Sutter County Sheriff. Brandon Barnes, for Sutter County Sheriff, was also scheduled to speak but due to a scheduling issue, he did not make it. It has been proposed that Brandon Barnes be invited to speak at the May 15 meeting, along with the two candidates for Yuba County Sheriff, and that Deborah Christensen Short be moved to the June 19 meeting.

The candidates were each given 15-20 minutes to speak about their background, qualifications, and their plans if they are elected. Questions were encouraged, asked, and answered.
