### Yuba Sutter Bar Association Meeting Minutes, October 15, 2019, The Refuge Restaurant

- 1. Courtney Gengler, President, began the meeting with welcoming remarks and announcements.
  - Yuba County District Attorney's Office is recruiting for a Deputy District Attorney. See the email for more information.
  - Our next meeting will be Monday November 4, 2019 at noon at Marcello's Italian Restaurant in Yuba City. This meeting will be in conjunction with the Estate Planning Professionals of Yuba-Sutter. Steve Zeller, with Zeller Kern Wealth Advisors in Sacramento, will be presenting, "The Arriving Tsunami of Baby Boomers Exiting their Businesses." Lunch for this meeting at Marcello's will be \$20.
  - Budget Update
    - YSBA annual operating costs: approximately \$2,000 per year. This covers the accountant, the P.O. Box, the Registrar of Charitable Trusts, Franchise Tax Board, Statement of Information filed with the Secretary of State, the website, and our MCLE activity provider status. We also subsidize the lunch meetings, at approximately \$1,000 per year, and pay for the Christmas party at approximately \$500 per year, for a total of \$3,500.
    - Our only income is member dues, and this year we only had about 50 people pay dues. In order for this association to continue to function, we need everyone to pay their dues.
    - We do not have enough money to pay for a holiday party this year, so unless anyone has any suggestions, we will not be able to have one.
    - We discussed multiple options to bring in enough money to pay for our operating expenses, and for the year 2020, we decided to raise member dues to \$75. It is only a \$25 increase for the entire year. If we were to raise the cost of lunches to \$20, it would be an increase in \$45 per person if you came to all 9 meetings.
- This month's presentation was "Cellphone Forensics: Applications in Discovery and Investigations." Our presenter was Roger Martin, a Senior Digital Forensics Examiner at Califorensics, Sacramento. He has presented on digital forensic-related topics at conferences throughout Northern California as

a subject matter expert and has over 13 years of experience in the field. Mr. Martin is a retired Police Detective for the Santa Rosa, CA Police Department. He started his career in digital forensics by opening his own business in 2006, Keyhole Computer Forensics. In 2007, he joined BlackBag Technologies, Inc., an industry-leader in forensic tools for Apple products, where he actively participated in the development and Quality Assurance process for Blacklight, BlackBag Technologies' flagship digital forensic suite. Mr. Martin has continued to apply his expertise of Mac operating systems, developing several automated forensic solutions for collection, conversion and remediation.

Mr. Martin's slide show presentation was very informative. He spoke about different types of mobile technology, the information they store, and the ways to retrieve that information. The presentation information was provided in booklet form to all attendees.
