Meeting Minutes

September 19, 2017

The Refuge Restaurant

- 1. Charles Poulos, President, began the meeting with welcoming remarks and announcements.
  - 1. Member Dues for 2017 are due, \$50.00. There is some discussion about prorating the dues for the last few months of the year.
  - 2. The Third Appellate District Judicial Conference will be held on Friday, October 13, 2017 through Saturday, October 14, 2017.

- The speaker, Assemblymember James Gallagher, discussed various bills that are going through
  the legislative process, including the gas tax bill, a housing bond, the Sanctuary State Bill (SB 54),
  the bill to improve dam inspections and evaluations, and the bill to limit the placement of
  sexually violent predators.
- 3. Charles Poulos, President, thanked the speaker and adjourned the meeting.
