He served as a Judge Pro Tem at the Colusa County Superior Court from 2019 to 2022 and was a Sole Practitioner from 2008 to 2020. He earned a Juris Doctor degree from Cal Northern School of Law.

Dr. Luu provided an overview on Substance Use Disorders, the drug overdose epidemic and its local impact in Yuba and Sutter Counties, treatment options for opioid user disorders, and challenges in accessing care for substance use disorders.
