1. Melissa Poulos called the meeting to order.
2. Melissa Poulos made announcements:
 - CRLA is having the first Know Your Rights Immigration Workshop on 2/28/2026 at Mahal Plaza at 1 p.m. This will be a trilingual workshop (English, Punjabi, and Spanish.)
 - The Sutter County Courthouse will be hosting two mock trial competitions:
 - o Faith Christian High School vs. Lindhurst High School on Monday, March 23, 2026, from 1-3 p.m.
 - o Sutter High School vs. Marysville High School on Friday, March 6, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
 - We are now accepting applications from local high school seniors for YSBA's Donald E. Huckins Memorial Scholarship. The deadline is April 17, 2026.
